SHOW #1--2012

Tune into Fishing the Midwest this week for a preview of some of the action you'll be seeing in 2012. Adam Sorenson from Dakota Grills shares a recipe for preparing a walleye, and we take a look at Bob Jensen's Ranger 1860 Angler boat.

SHOW #2--2012

Joe Honer, Bill Leonard, and Bob Jensen use an ice-fishing bait, the Puppet Minnow, for open water walleyes in South Dakota on the first part of Fishing the Midwest this week. Later, Bob joins Tom Neustrom and Rob Hamling to catch bluegills through the ice in north central Minnesota.

SHOW #3--2012

Lake Winnibigoshish in north central Minnesota is the site of some outstanding walleye action this week on Fishing the Midwest. Joe Thompson and Craig Brown, long-time Winnie anglers, show Bob Jensen around Winnie and catch lots of walleyes and perch.

SHOW #4--2012

Perch are the target on the first part of Fishing the Midwest this week. Bob Jensen joins a group of ice-anglers in the Grand Rapids area of Minnesota to learn more about perch fishing through the ice. Then it's off to Sturgeon Bay Wisconsin to catch smallmouth bass in clear water with guide Bret Alexander and Jeff Kolodzinski.

SHOW #5--2012

Storm Lake in west central Iowa is one of the Midwest's hottest walleye lakes. Join Jim McDonnell, Gary Lalone, and Bob Jensen to learn how to catch Storm Lake walleyes and to take a visit around the town of Storm Lake.

SHOW #6--2012

Fishing the Midwest starts out this week on the Mississippi River between Lansing Iowa and Prairie du Chien Wisconsin. Terry Fitzpatrick and Doug Veldhuizen from Cabela's get together with Bob Jensen for some fast fall fishing for largemouth and smallmouth bass. Then it's off to catch some perch through the ice near Walker Minnesota.

SHOW #7--2012

The action is fast on Green Bay in Wisconsin on Fishing the Midwest this week. Area guide Bret Alexander shows Jeff Kolodzinski and Bob Jensen how to catch Green Bay walleyes on planer boards. Although walleyes are the target, this afternoon on the water results in a mixed bag.

SHOW #8--2012

Bob Jensen joins Clay Norris and Joe Meyer on West Lake Okoboji in northwest Iowa to catch largemouth bass on crankbaits and to learn a little bit about Nanofil on this week's installment of Fishing the Midwest television. SHOW #9--2012

The northeast corner of South Dakota offers some of the best fishing anywhere for walleyes. Jim Seuer and Bob Jensen get together with area fishing guide Joe Honer to throw crankbaits in the timber for walleyes and to learn more about the advantages that ethanol provides for the outdoors-person.

Show #10--2012

Mike Frisch and his daughter Hannah show Bob Jensen their secrets for catching largemouth bass in the summer on a trip to western Minnesota.
